CRACKERS CHRONICLES – LATE EIGHTIES

Welcome back to **“Crackers Chronicles”**. This week we trace some of the history of the *Old Scotch Football Club* by recounting the contributions of four of our Life Members from the late 1980s.

R. W. Rob Fuller (“Frosty”)

Rob Fuller was recruited from *Scotch College* in 1982, where he was Captain of Football in 1982 & 1983, and played five games while still at school. He then played four games for *Richmond FC* in 1984. He returned to our club in 1985 and played 157 games for the *Old Scotch Collegians Football Club* in 1982 and from 1985 – 1995. He was a Victorian representative in 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994 & 1995. He captained Victoria in 1987, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993 & 1994. He was also an Australian Amateur Football Council representative in 1986, 1988, 1989 & 1994, and captained Australia in 1989 & 1994.

Rob captained our Club for nine years from 1987 – 1995.

He was named VAFA Personality of the Year in 1993 and awarded a VAFA Certificate of Merit in 1994.

In 2000, he was named as vice-captain of the *OSCFC Team of the Century*.

He was awarded a Life Member of the Club in 2001, and named a Legend of the Big V in 2007.

Rob is brother of OSCFC player Keith Fuller (1980 – 1993).

R. R. Rohan Aujard (“Plugger”)

Rohan Aujard was recruited from *Scotch College* in 1986. He played 252 games for the *Old Scotch Collegians Football Club* from 1986 – 2002. He was our Under 19s Best & Fairest in 1987 and VAFA “Under 19 Section 2” Best & Fairest.

He was also our club’s leading goalkicker in 1989 & 1997, and club Best & Fairest in 1990 (only the second OSCFC player to be Best & Fairest in both our Under 19s and Seniors).

He was awarded a Life Member of the Club in 1997 upon playing 200 games for our Club, and later Reserves leading goalkicker in 2001.

He was a major sponsor of our Club for 12 years from 2000 – 2011.

J. D. R. Jon Kerr

Jon Kerr was recruited from *Scotch College* in 1986. He played 264 games for the *Old Scotch Collegians Football Club* from 1986 – 2001, captained our Under 19s in 1988, was our Reserves Best & Fairest in 1990 & 1991, and played in our Reserves premiership team of 1993.

He was awarded a Life Member of the Club in 1998 upon playing 200 games for our Club.

N. M. T. Nick Hooper

Nick Hooper was recruited from *Scotch College* in 1987. He went on and played a record 316 games for the *Old Scotch Collegians Football Club* from 1987 – 2003. He was our Under 19s Best & Fairest in 1988, VAFA “Under 19 Section 2” Best & Fairest in 1988, our Reserves leading goalkicker in 1990 & 2002, and our Reserves Best & Fairest in 1992, 1996, 1997, 1999 & 2002.

Nick played in our Reserves premiership team of 1993 and captained our Reserves for six years from 1996 - 2000 and again in 2003.

He was awarded a Life Member of the Club in 1997 upon playing 200 games for our Club.

Nick is brother of OSCFC player David Hooper (1987 – 1998).
