Old Scotch Football Club RESERVES GRAND FINALS

Welcome back to "Crackers Chronicles". This week we will trace some of the history of the Old Scotch Football Club by recounting the contributions made by some of our Reserves teams.

In **1958**, the club founded a second senior team to afford players who failed to attain selection in our senior team the chance to play football. Following a meeting between six interested clubs, Old Scotch, Ivanhoe, Old Caulfield Grammarians, Old Xaverians, Old Paradians and Old Melburnians, it was decided to institute a premiership 2nds competition with an organised draw. The matches would be curtain raisers to "A" grade matches and would be umpired by the Association umpires. They were determined to prove to the VAFA that a reserve grade competition was a necessity in the Association.

In **1958 & 1959**, the teams operated as an independent competition. The annual fixture consisted of games against other VAFA clubs who could field a second team. In 1958, the Grand Final was between *Old Scotch* and *Ivanhoe*. In 1959, *Old Paradians* 13.12.90 defeated *Old Scotch* 6.10.70. However, in **1960** the *Old Scotch Collegians Football Club* was a prime-mover, together with *Old Paradians*, in formalising a ten-team 2nds competition under the VAFA banner. In 1961 it blossomed into two sections of ten teams each and by 1965 into five Reserves grade sections aligned to the Senior sections.

In the 58 years from 1960 to 2017, our Reserves have appeared in 18 Reserves Section Grand Finals, winning 8 and losing 10:
