Welcome back to this week's edition of "Crackers Chronicles".

Each week in this column we will trace some of the history of the *Old Scotch Football Club* by recounting the contributions made by our great club presidents.

This week we focus on our club presidents of the 1960s ...

N. C. Norm Cossar 1960 - 1965

Norm Cossar was an old boy of *Scotch College* and served as the sixth President of the *Old Scotch Collegians Football Club* for six years from 1960 – 1965. During his term, the club won a B Section premiership in 1965. His son Brian Cossar, also an old *Scotch College* boy, played with our club in 1956 until injury cut short his playing career. The Cossar family were significant financial supporters of our club for many years. From 1957, Henry Francis Chemists, where Norm was a partner, supplied medical supplies free to our club for twenty years.

K. M. Keith Campbell 1966 - 1968

Keith Campbell played in the *Scotch College* School 1st XVIII Football Team in 1920 and joined the *Old Scotch Collegians Football Club* in 1922. He later re-joined the club in 1926 and played a total of four seasons with our club 1922 & 1926 – 1928. He played in our 1927 A Section premiership team. Keith served as the seventh President of the *Old Scotch Collegians Football Club* for three years 1966 – 1968.

His son Euan Campbell, also an old *Scotch College* boy, played 148 games with our club from 1963 – 1974

His grandson Darren Campbell (Euan's son) also played 73 games with our club from 1981 – 1988.
